#### Dear students and colleagues!

We invite you to take part in the annual International Conference of Schoolchildren «Language and the World», which will be held in Moscow, at the Linguistic School for the eighteenth time; it always arouses great interest and receives high appreciation from participants and guests. The previous conference was attended by 59 schoolchildren from Moscow, Aprelevka, Balashikha, Drezna, Samara, Ufa, Irkutsk, Petrozavodsk, Kazan, Yakutia, Singapore, who presented 53 reports. There were 3 sections: «Language and Culture», «Language, mentoring culture», «Language, regional studies. The world around us». All conference participants received certificates, the winners and prize—winners of the research and design competition received diplomas of 1, 2 and 3 degrees, the winners in the nominations were awarded with diplomas: the most socially significant topic, the most relevant topic, the best presentation, the practical significance of the project, the best report in English, etc.

Since 2022, Language and the World Conference has been held within the framework of the Decade of Indigenous Languages, but its topics cover a wide range of issues related to history, culture, education, politics, social sphere, science and many other topics of interest to students. In Russia, 2024 has been declared the Year of the Family, and we expect participants to work on this relevant topic. If the research does not quite fit into the thematic framework of the conference, but is of interest and performed at an appropriate standard, then the organizing committee will be ready to consider your application for participation.

Form of participation: full-time or remote

### Thematic sections of the conference

- 1. The modern linguistic picture of the world. Languages of the world, problems of preserving ethnic and linguistic diversity. Modern language policy. The ecology of language. The diversity and interaction of languages. Language adaptation and migration policy in modern society. Psycholinguistics as a way of in-depth study of speech and language.
- 2. Indigenous peoples of Russia and world: history and modernity (linguistic and cultural characteristics of indigenous peoples of Russia and the world, traditions, mindset, ethnopolitics, famous personalities representatives of indigenous peoples, their achievements and contribution to the culture and art of their land). Cultural cooperation, rapprochement and interaction of cultures, interethnic and intraethnic relations. Problems of preserving cultural traditions.
- 3. Modern education: issues, achievements, trends, goals. Educational policy. Unity of the learning and upbringing process. Best world practices. Features of national educational programs. Indigenous languages in education systems. Education at different stages of the development of society. Culture and education. How not to make a mistake with the choice of profession. Professions of the future.
- 4. The year of the family in Russia, as well as the topics in the area of "Language and the world" at the participant's discretion.
